FAX numbers for authorizations and claims appeals will remain the same

National Imaging Associates (NIA) expanded scope reviewing authorization for outpatient cardiac procedures and outpatient rehab (physical, occupational, and speech therapy services)

MPC continues to require certain laboratory/radiology procedures to be done in non-regulated space. If done in regulated space, authorization will now be required



PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION CHANGES CONTINUED

What Will Remain the Same

- MPC provider network and your existing contract
- Current MPC Provider and Member toll free phone and fax numbers
- MPC DentaQuest Adult Dental, ESI Pharmacy, and Superior Vision benefit managers
- Oncology and radiation oncology requests will continue to require an Eviti code
- Open authorizations as of 1/1/21 will not need to have an additional authorization requested (1/1/21 or after)

Text messaging/letter/calls	Multi-modal communication platform to engage membership into care
Home Visits- Due to COVID restrictions, expanded services to include tele-health are offered to the MPC population with no coverage area restrictions. Tele-health visits will continue to the SSI Adult/SSI child populations	Alegis will re-evaluate home visits to unengaged members for SSI Adult, Lead, and HbA1c testing Jan/Feb. Coverage areas: Baltimore/Central MD, PG and Montgomery Counties
Remote Access Scheduling- Providers who grant MPC remote access scheduling	MPC will provide targeted outreach for Value-based purchasing Gaps in Care. Outreach includes telephonic/text/calls and scheduling directly to PCP office. For more information, please call Sammi at 410-412-0394.
Clinic Days- Will continue in 2021 for BCS, HbA1c, Lead, SSI populations	MPC will continue to offer the BCS populations \$150 incentive for completion of mammograms during scheduled clinic days. Incentives for HbA1c, Lead, SSI TBD
Health Fairs-MPC did place a hold on Health Fairs. The plan is currently evaluating the best approach to modify/ resume clinic days for the rest of CY 2021. Resume date: TBD- planning for Summer or Fall of 2021	Large events (200-400 members) that include external stakeholders: Health Departments, providers, and community resource vendors. Goal is to close gaps in care, provide health education and address socio-economic disparities



Post-Partum

MPC developed a text campaign for post-partum populations. Members will receive a text 7-10 days after delivery and again at 49 days if they remain non-compliant. MPC is offering a \$50.00 incentive to total population completing the PPC visit.

Pharmacy Policy Review

Effective 01/01/2021:

- Partnership with Evolent Health will begin and contract with Centene will end
- Due to this transition, MPC evaluated the medications currently being reviewed by Centene and our PBM
- The medications with utilization criteria will now be reviewed by Evolent Health and Express Scripts
- The medication lists have been divided into two categories:
 - Medications obtained by members in an outpatient retail setting that can be selfadministered – Express Script
 - Medications administered by a healthcare professional Evolent Health
