## You now have premium access to the best doctors and hospitals in the state.

Please note that your MPC member handbook is available for you to view or download anytime. Go to <a href="mailto:mpcMedicaid.com">mpcMedicaid.com</a>, click on the 'For Members' tab, and select 'MPC Medicaid Handbook (PDF)'. The handbook can be saved to your device or printed out for future reference. If you do not have internet access available, you can also request a printed copy of the MPC member handbook by calling Member Services, Monday through Friday 8 am to 5 pm at 800-953-8854.



#### Your MPC Member ID card is inside.

- If anything is wrong with the ID card, call 800-953-8854 right away.
- Keep your card in a safe place.
- Always bring your card with you to healthcare appointments.
- If you lose your ID card, call MPC Member Services right away, and we'll send you another one.
- Your ID card is for your use only—don't let anyone else use it; you can lose your Medicaid eligibility if you let someone else use your card.



#### **Choose your Primary Care Provider (PCP)**

Your PCP is the doctor or nurse practitioner who manages your medical care; you must choose a PCP on our website at <a href="mpcMedicaid.com/find-a-provider">mpcMedicaid.com/find-a-provider</a>. We can help you find a provider; just call 800-953-8854.

- New members should make an appointment for an initial health exam within three months of joining MPC.
- Your PCP can refer you to a specialist if you need one.
- It's OK to change your PCP for any reason; just call 800-953-8854. You'll get a new ID card with the name of your new PCP within ten days of your request.



## **MyVirtualMPC**: Chat with a doctor from anywhere, even after hours.

MyVirtualMPC is an app that lets you skip the trip to the doctor's office or clinic. Within seconds, you can send a secure chat message and share images or videos with a local doctor – at no cost to you.

- Available 24 hours, 7 days a week
- Works on your laptop, tablet, or smartphone

#### Free Cell Phone

The Safelink phone program, offered by the state of Maryland, provides eligible households with a free cell phone and phone service plan. With your free cell phone, you get:

- 350 free minutes a month
- Free unlimited text messaging
- Free calls to our Member Services

If you need non-emergency care after normal business hours, you can use the free MyVirtualMPC mobile app for a quick video visit with a local doctor.

Call 911 or go to the nearest emergency department when you need emergency care.

#### True emergencies include:

- Sharp chest pains
- Passing out
- Severe burns
- Bleeding that will not stop
- Poisoning
- Extreme shortness of breath

# Urgent care centers can treat illness or injury that is non-life-threatening:

- Colds/flu/fever
- Sore throat
- Earaches
- Pink eye
- Vomiting/diarrhea
- Urinary tract infection
- Rashes
- Minor cuts
- Moderate headaches

You can go to an MPC urgent care center when your PCP is unavailable. They are open longer hours and on weekends, and you don't need an appointment. A list of urgent care centers included with your MPC membership is at mpcMedicaid.com/find-a-provider.
