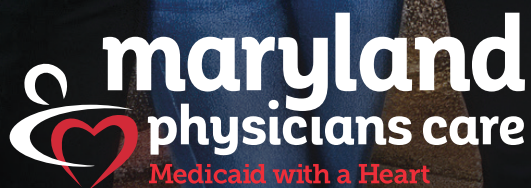

Community Impact Story

Maryland Physicians Care invested in the Western Maryland Food Bank in Q4 2025, enabling expansion of the backpack program and providing more children and families with essential food. Because of MPC's contribution, more students now have access to meals outside of school hours.

The impact of MPC's investment is truly life-changing.



Amy Moyer, Executive Director of the Western Maryland Food Bank, has seen this impact firsthand:

Some of the things that have stuck with me, in doing the backpack program, I had a friend who was a media specialist in the school, and she had a student who was in, and he was kind of being silly, and she was like, "What's going on with you?" And his response was, "Did you hear I eat on the weekends now?"

Another instance was when I was picking up my own son in high school, and he had a boy he asked me to take home. I knew he had visited the school pantry. That's part of why he needed the ride home. He had the groceries, and he was whispering to my son, and my son turned around and said, "Oh, that's what my mom does."

Through that, the young man started volunteering at the food bank, preparing food for his school pantry. He was helping pick it up and get it out. And when they went to load it to take it to the school, he got to help through that whole process.

And that's just one of those really special things to see, somebody so thankful. That he wasn't ashamed to share with my son or with the other kids that he had started volunteering at the food bank because of the help he had received.
